Best known for her research on radiation, she was the first woman to receive a Nobel Prize in Physics. She remains the only woman to receive the award twice, after later winning a Nobel Prize in Chemistry.

Gabriella Bonhuer "Coco" Chanel

In 1928, this trailblazing aviator was the first female to fly solo (alone) across the Atlantic Ocean - a journey that took 20 hours!

Beatrix Potter

A famous illustrator and writer, she is most famous for her illustrated books recalling the tales of the mischievous Peter Rabbit.

Marie Curie

The first woman elected as Prime Minister of a Muslim state, a title she held from 1988-1990, and again from 1993-1996.

Amelia Earhart

This fashion designer revolutionized women's clothing, creating the casually elegant style that is still famous today (along with her No.5 perfume).
