

Spread Your Wings and Fly!

Color and create a bluethroat. Tug on the string to flap its wings!

Materials

- Crayons or colored markers
- Child-safe scissors
- Glue stick
- String




- Cut line
- Fold line · · · · · · · · · ·


Directions

- 1. Color and cut out the bird body and wings.
- **2.** Fold the body along the dotted line and glue the two sides together.

- **3.** Fold the wings down along the center dotted line. Then fold the wings up along the outer dotted lines.
- **4.** Tie the string around the center fold of the wings. Leave about an extra foot of string.
- **5.** Add glue to the GLUE HERE area on the bird body.
- **6.** Line up the center fold of the wings with the center fold of the GLUE HERE area of the bird body. Press together to attach.
- 7. Once the glue dries, give the string a little tug and watch the Bluethroat flap its wings!
