

# Kicking Zebra

One way a zebra protects itself from other animals is with a powerful kick.  
Create your own kicking zebra with this rocking zebra activity.

**Note:** Print out this activity on cardstock, or print out the activity sheet and glue it onto a piece of cardboard.

## Materials

- Crayons or colored markers
- Child-safe scissors
- Tape

## Legend

- Cut line  - - - - -
- Fold line .....

## Directions

1. Color and cut out all the parts of the zebra.
2. Fold the body in half along the dotted line.
3. Ask an adult to cut along the pink lines on the fold to create two slots.
4. Put the zebra's neck into one slot until the mane touches the fold and tape it to the inside of the body.
5. Put the zebra's tail in the other slot.
6. Fold the head and tail along their dotted lines to make them stick up.
7. Tape the front and back legs to the inside of the body.
8. Give your zebra a nudge and watch it kick!
