



One way a zebra protects itself from other animals is with a powerful kick.

Create your own kicking zebra with this rocking zebra activity.

**Note:** Print out this activity on cardstock, or print out the activity sheet and glue it onto a piece of cardboard.

## **Materials**


- Crayons or colored markers
- Child-safe scissors
- Tape

## Legend

- Cut line
- Fold line · · · · · · · · · ·

## **Directions**

- 1. Color and cut out all the parts of the zebra.
- 2. Fold the body in half along the dotted line.
- **3.** Ask an adult to cut along the pink lines on the fold to create two slots.
- **4.** Put the zebra's neck into one slot until the mane touches the fold and tape it to the inside of the body.
- 5. Put the zebra's tail in the other slot.
- **6.** Fold the head and tail along their dotted lines to make them stick up.
- **7.** Tape the front and back legs to the inside of the body.
- 8. Give your zebra a nudge and watch it kick!



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
